On 13 of June Macedonian .NET User Group, under the hat of INETA and Microsoft organized first Code Camp event in Skopje, Macedonia.

With more than 130+ attendees, which was great number, we organized event with famous international, regional and local speakers.

Microsoft MVP and INETA Speaker Serge Luca (Belgium), hold two sessions at the start of the event with content that touched the attendees and produce long discussions. Also Martin Kulov (Bulgaria), INETA Speaker and Microsoft MVP, had great session in his expertise. Our neighbor Srgjan Bozovic (Serbia), Microsoft MVP, also participated with session. Our recognized local speakers Boban Stojanovski (Microsoft MVP), Vladimir Meloski (Microsoft MVP) and Dejan Anevski (Winner of INETA Europe Silverlight Challenge) had once more proved themselves as quality speakers.
